Trusted Mentors 2013 Annual Report of Outcomes

In 2013, Trusted Mentors continued to grow in the number of clients and agencies served. We saw a 20% increase in the number of matches (from 86 to 116) and a 40% increase in the number of agencies served (from 17 to 24).
